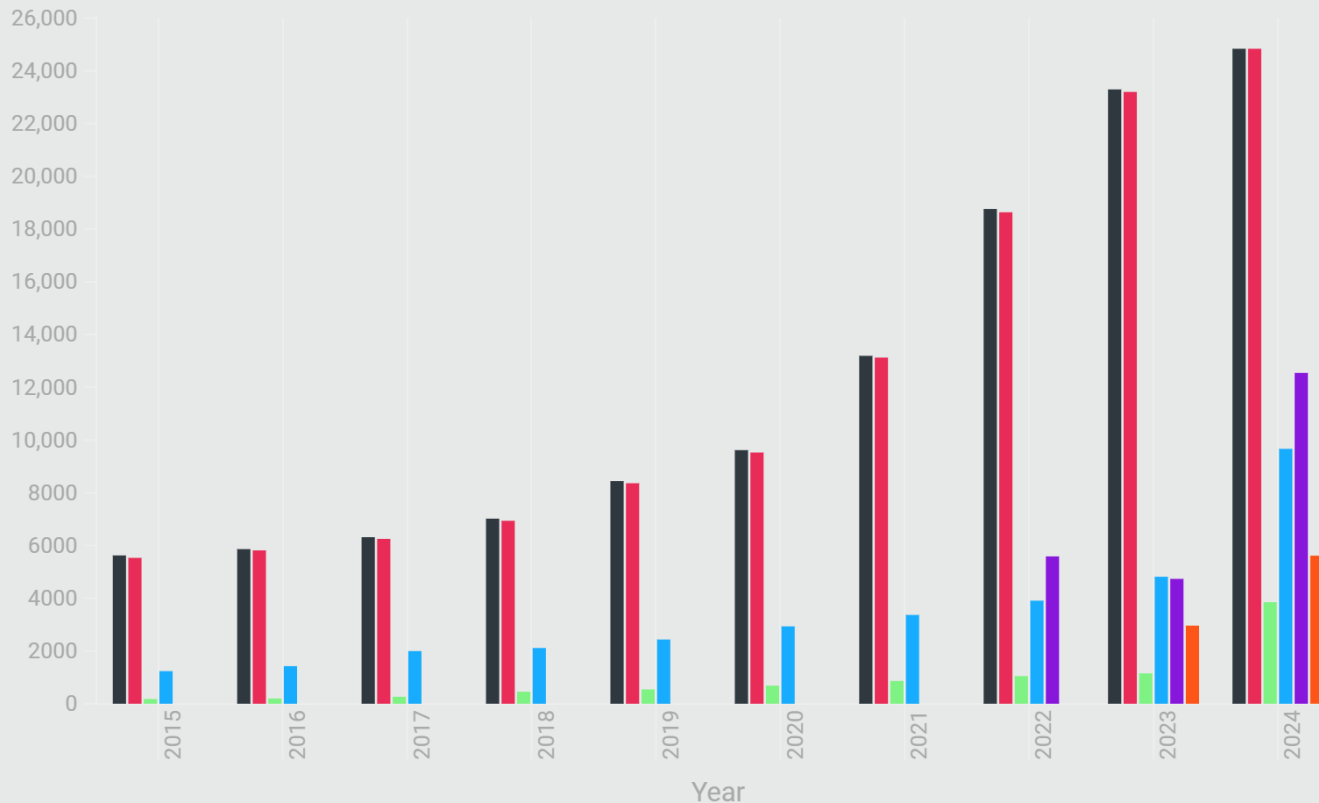

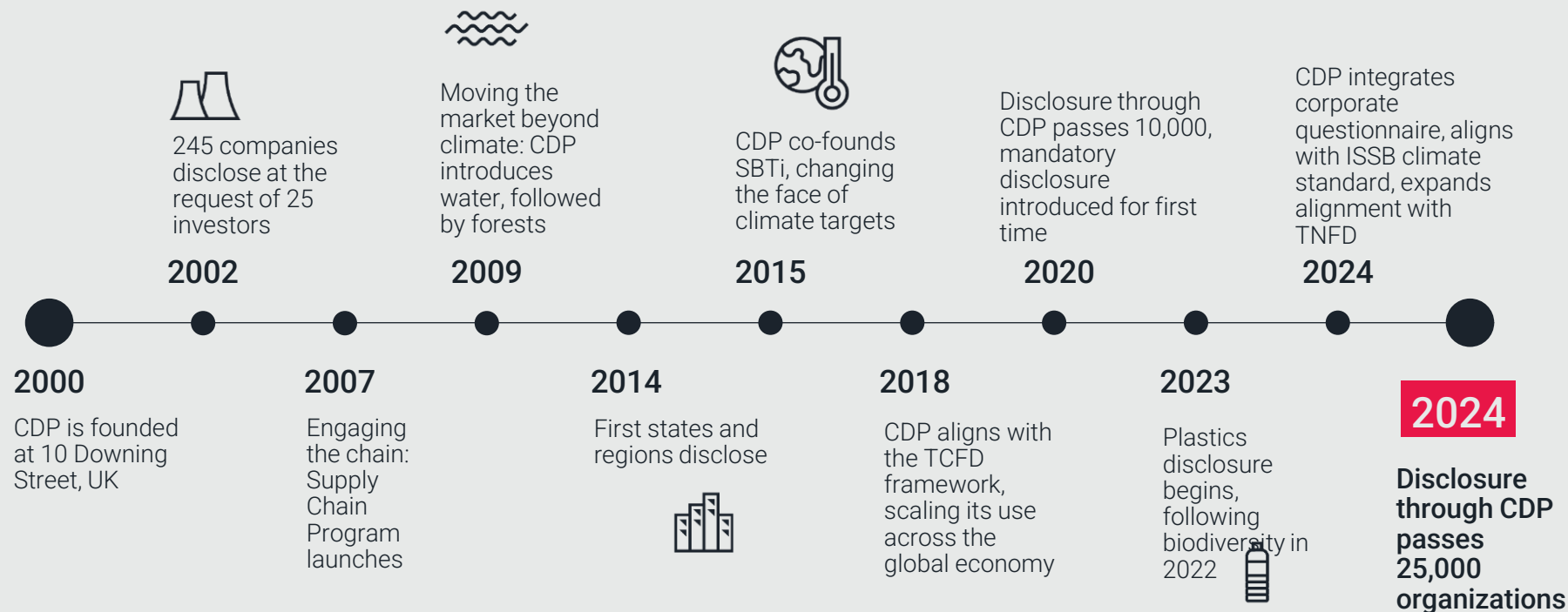

Improved translations of the questionnaire in Chinese, Japanese, Spanish and Portuguese.

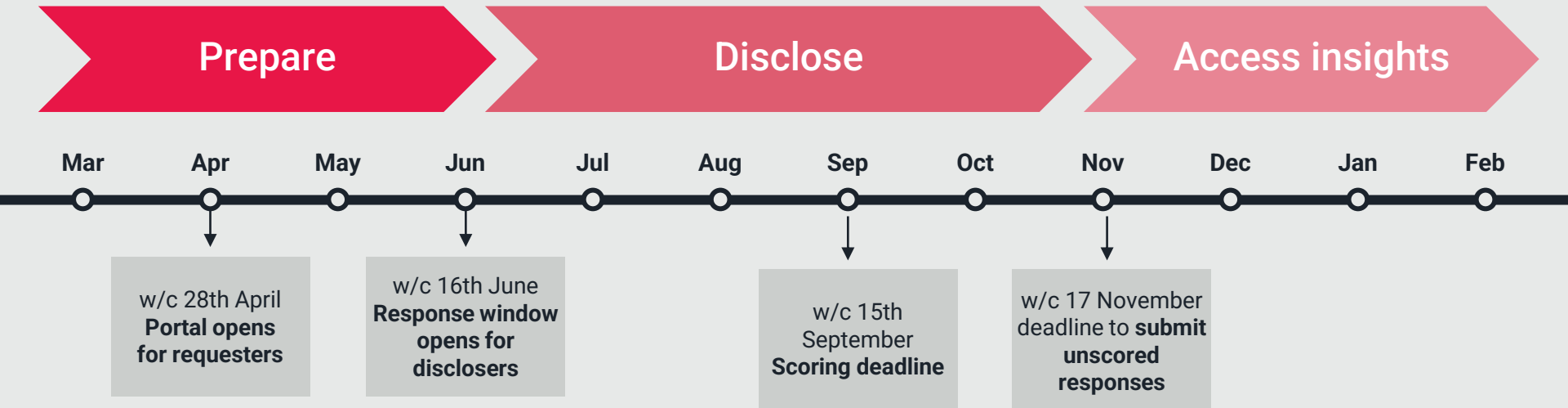

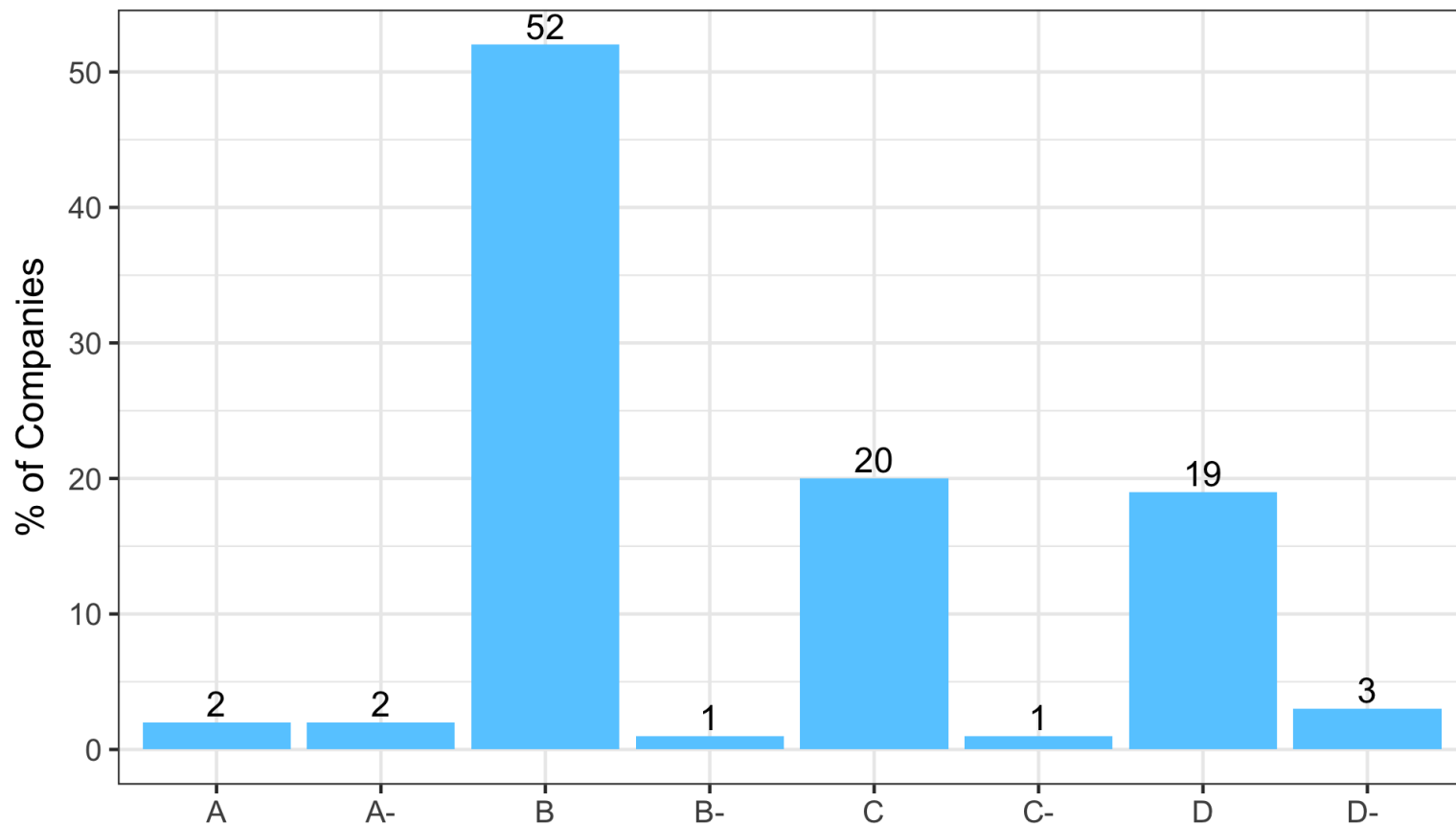

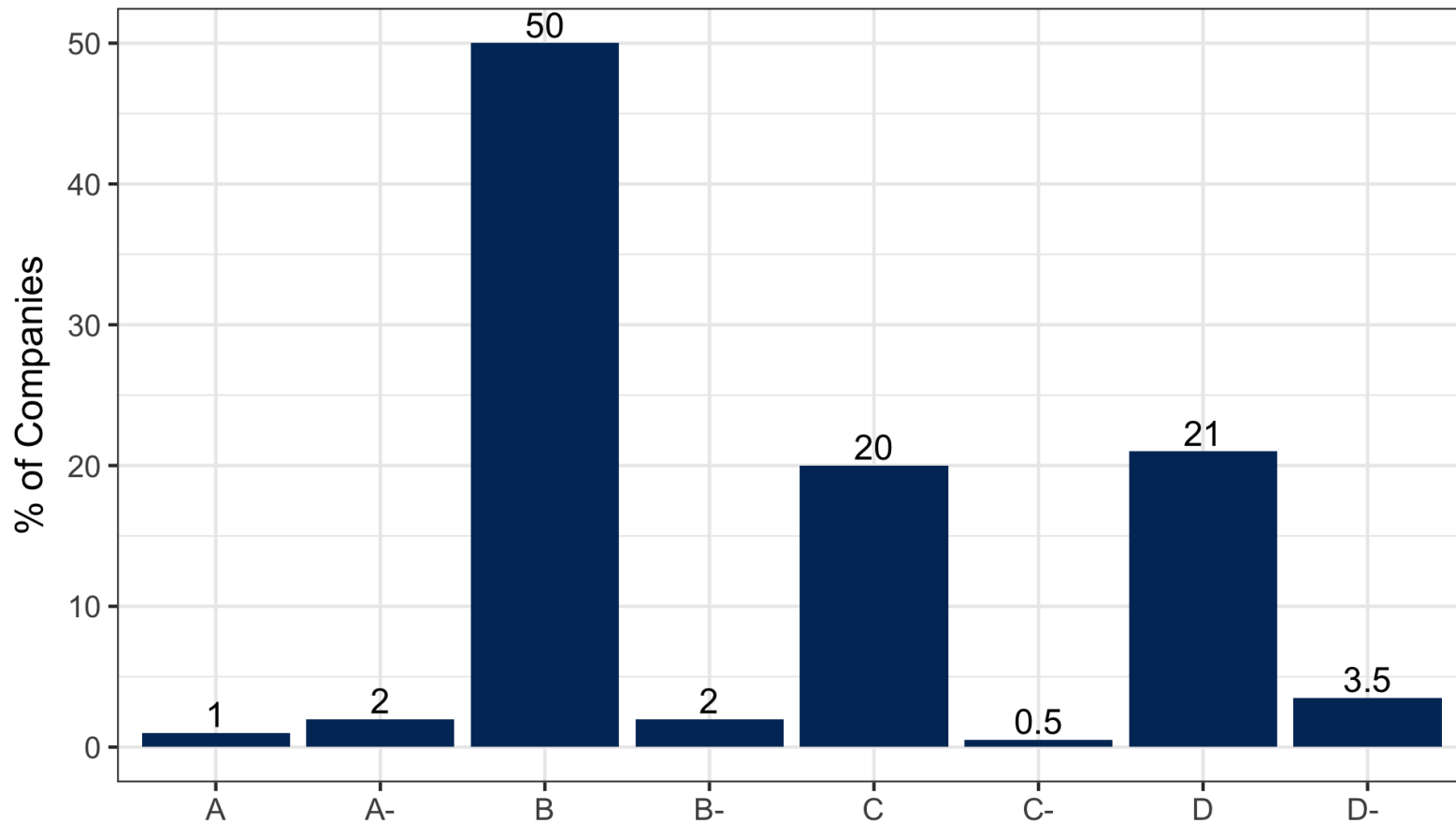
Distribution of Climate Change Scores for Companies in HQ Country (Ireland)



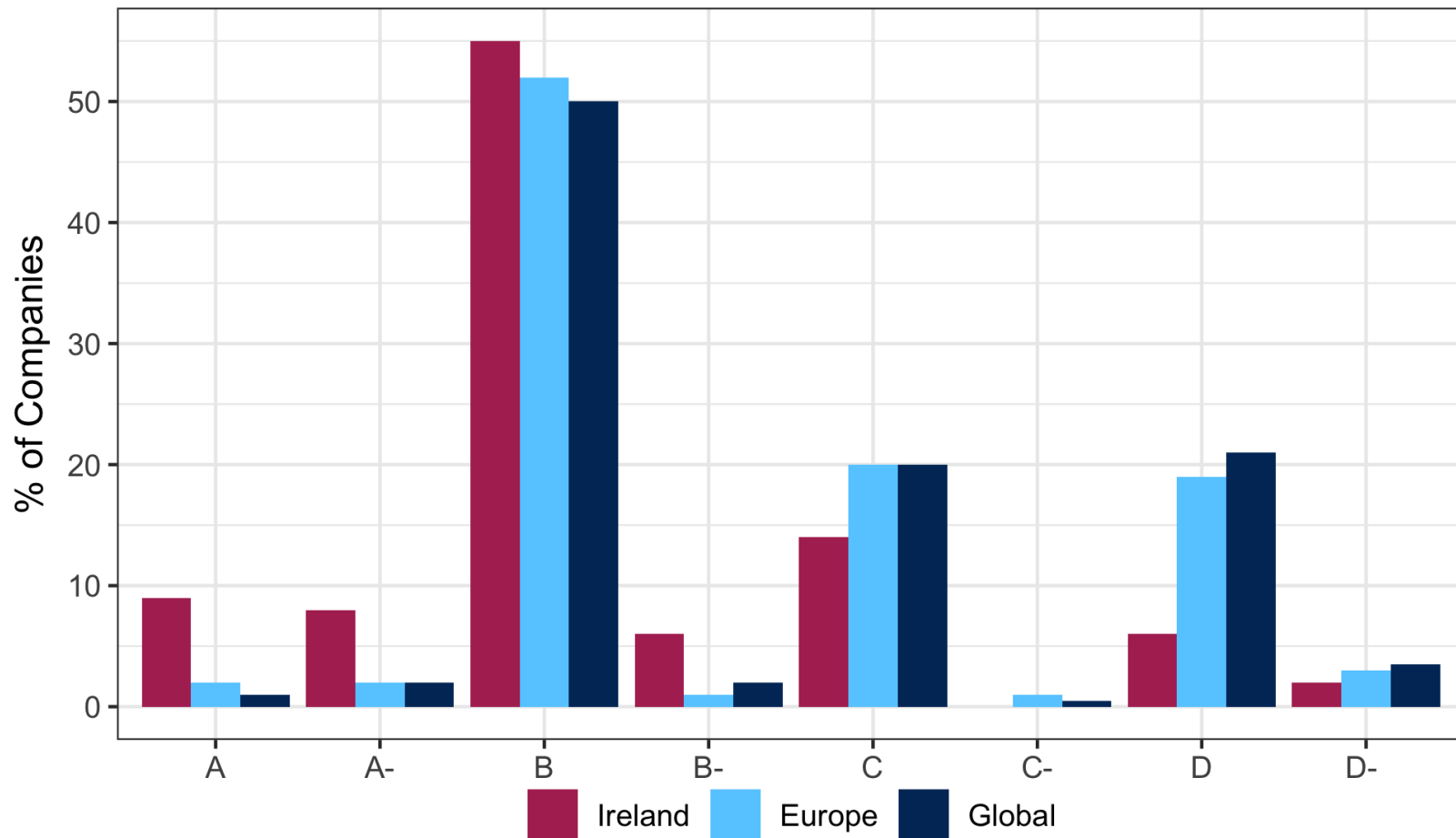
Distribution of Climate Change Scores for Companies in Region (Europe)

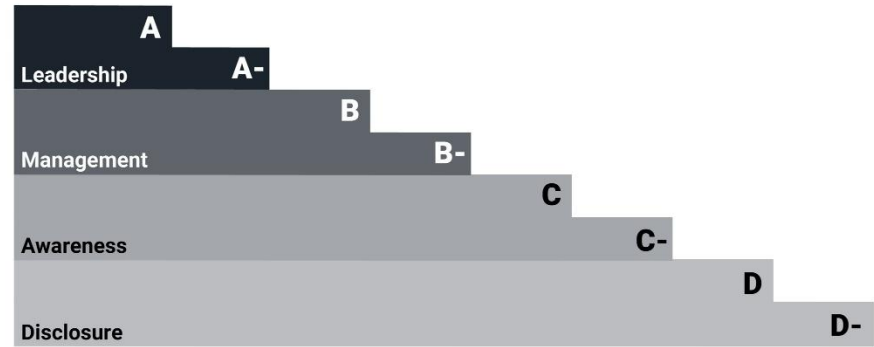
